Course Title: Brexit – Impact on ASEAN and Singapore: How might it affect the work of Singapore lawyers?

Course description: On 23rd June 2016, the UK voted 52% to 48% to leave the European Union in a historic referendum (the so-called Brexit referendum). Sterling plunged, UK Prime Minister David Cameron announced his resignation, and the rest of the EU nations struggled to deal with the reasons and ramifications of the Brexit vote.

The impact of the Brexit vote was not confined to Europe. Many Asian companies that once regarded the UK as a safe foothold in the EU Single Market saw the landscape upended by the Brexit vote. The Brexit vote raises significant challenges and potential opportunities for all multinational companies that conduct business in the UK or with UK companies. With London's place as an international financial centre mired in uncertainty, multinational companies may begin looking elsewhere, perhaps in Asia, and this could be an opportunity for Singapore.

This programme aims to provide practitioners with an understanding of the timeline of Brexit, the legal complexities of the process, and the impact on ASEAN and Singapore. The programme will look at Japan's response to Brexit and whether this indicates how other countries in Asia may react. This programme will also discuss any possible impacts of Brexit on the work of Singapore lawyers – what to (reasonably) expect and how best to be prepared.
